Background

The International Workshop on Biosafety Laboratory Management and Techniques is hosted by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China and the Chinese Academy of Sciences (CAS), and organized by Wuhan Institute of Virology (WIV), CAS. The workshop is designed for laboratory managers and directors, research and laboratory staff who plan to carry out infectious disease research in biosafety facilities from the developing countries.
